**Birmingham Still Faces Expansion in School System**

School Superintendent Dwight B. Ireland told education board members Tuesday night that Birmingham must continue looking toward a building expansion program.

He revealed a possible enrollment of at least 432 pupils for Baldwin elementary school as soon as the new high school of completion.

The Baldwin elementary enrollment will raise the situation in some of the schools but not all, he said. "It can help Pontiac and little effect on the others."
