Vacation time for Barnum Junior high school is soon to see the close of the most extensive sports program in its history, according to Athletic Director Frank White.

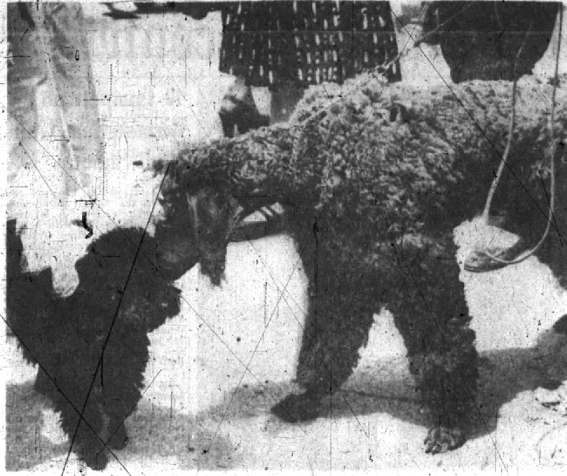
