Two Local Youths Graduate From Culver Academy

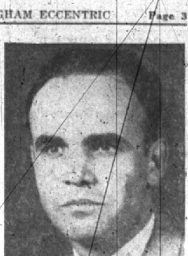
Two Birmingham youths were among the 151 cadets from 29 states and seven foreign countries who graduated from Culver Military Academy in Indiana at traditional "Iron Gate" ceremonies Sunday, June 6.

In the four years, Erickson attended Culver, he has earned the Silver and Gold "A" in recognition of high academic achievement and was elected to membership in Om Laude, national, honorary scholastic society.

HE WAS ALSO awarded the Rauch and Lomb science medal given to the student who in the estimation of the science staff has shown the greatest progress in science during his high school career. Having earned this award, Erickson automatically becomes eligible to apply for one of the five annual scholarships to the University of Rochester.
