Christ Church Cranbrook's fourth grade Sunday school girls have a new "daughter", 10-year old Helga Bauer, whose home is in Austria. Helga's mother is almost totally blind and the youngest in her family is in need of outside help.

Mrs. Allan Lutz, class teacher, said last week that the girls were glad to "adopt" the child. A complete outfit of clothing and regular supplementary rations of food, or money, for the next year will be provided.

"The girls are all excited about it," she said, "and are eager to do everything they possibly can. One box of clothing has already been sent and more are being planned. They have even gotten their mothers interested in the plight of Mrs. Bauer, wanting to know if she needs clothing or additional food supplies."

Letters from Helga will be translated, if necessary, at the offices of the Save the Children Federation, who arranged the "adoption."
