Local Artists to Appear On Musicales Program

The Birmingham Musicales will present its Choral Ensemble, under the direction of Gertrude Heinze Greer, when the organization meets on March 8 at 2 p.m. at the Community House.

Syver K. Thingstad, well-known baritone, will be featured as soloist with the Chorus when they present "The Harp Weaver", a choral ballad. The text is by the late Edna St. Vincent Millay. Miss Millay received the coveted Pulitzer prize in 1923 for this work, judged to be the best book of verse by an American author that year. It has been set to music by Elinor Renick Warren, for women's chorus and baritone solo.

The Ensemble will also do two choruses from "L'Allegro" by Handel, with two pianos. Jean

Whalley and Aya Jean Vigstedt will be the accompanists.

JEAN LOOFBOURROW, pianist, will do a group of Robert Schumann selections from "Fantasietücke", opus 12 as her part of the day's program.

Gertrude Heinze Greer has been directing the Choral Ensemble for eleven years. The group has appeared professionally before many clubs as well as doing two programs annually before the Musicales. Many of the Chorus members will attend the Michigan Federation of Music Clubs convention at Battle Creek, April 2, to sing with the Massed Chorus of over 200 voices which will be directed by Mrs. Greer, who is State Choral chairman.
