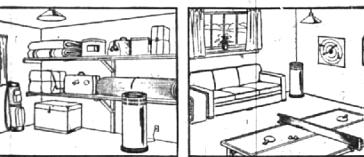

Two Local Items On April Ballot In Troy Twp.

When Troy township voters go to the polls April 2, two local matters will be on the ballot, besides the candidates for various township offices.
Residents will be asked to approve an appropriation for the purchase of a new water tank truck for the fire department, and decide whether or not hunting should be banned in the township.
Petitions filed at last Wednesday's township board meeting, requested the board to place the following question on the ballot: "That \$5,000 be appropriated for the purchase of a water tank truck for the fire department."
After receiving the petitions, the board placed the matter on the ballot.
Township Fire Marshal Clarence Carpenter previously appeared before the board in February and recommended the purchase of the truck for station two.
The other proposal previously approved is to have the voters decide whether or not hunting should be prohibited in Troy township for the next five years.
In other business at the meeting, petitions signed by 224 residents of the vicinity of 15 Mile

road and Livernois were received. These signers asked for more street lights in their area. At the present time, there is just lighting at the main intersections.
Board members received another group of petitions when 40 residents north of 15 Mile road and Livernois asked for extension of water mains to their area. They claim their wells are going dry.
The request was referred to the township engineer to prepare an estimate of the cost and report back to the board at the next meeting to determine if the project is financially possible.
An amount of \$1,000 was appropriated from the general fund to pay for hiring trucks for hauling gravel to fill bad spots in the roads.
