Local Garden Club Plans Open House

Home Gardeners of the Birmingham branch, Woman's National Farm and Garden Association, will hold an open meeting for all interested gardeners at the Baldwin Library next Monday night, March 12th, at 7:45.

Designed to attract new residents of Birmingham and the surrounding areas who are interested in home gardening, the meeting will feature ten minute talks on important phases of gardening followed by round table discussion.

In addition, a soil testing demonstration and discussion will be conducted by Willard Bosserman, assistant agricultural agent.

Speakers and the subjects to be covered are, Mrs. Kathleen Birch "Vegetable Gardening," Mrs. Gladys Dinnie, "Gardening with Flowering Shrubs and Perennials"; Mrs. Edna Marston, "Rose Culture" and Mrs. Anna Belle Webb, "Lawn Care". Besides demonstrating soil testing, Mr. Bosserman will discuss "Garden Soil Management," with particular reference to soil problems in this area.

In the round table to follow, Mrs. Webb will act as moderator, inviting questions and answers and a free interchange of information on Home Gardening, she stated: "The meeting is considered a very important one, since the month of March is essentially garden planning time. They are hopeful that there will be many new gardeners at the meeting as well as the many who regularly participate in this interesting department of the Garden Club work."

The Library will have an extensive catalog exhibit, plus many worthwhile garden books on display.
