Citizens of the United States, 21 years old, who have resided in the State of Michigan six months and in the Township of Bloomfield thirty days at the time of voting are eligible.

TO REGISTER, call at the Bloomfield Township Office at 4200 Telegraph Road between the hours of 9 A.M. and 5 P.M. except that on Tuesday, March 13, 1951, the office will be open from 9 A.M. to 8 P.M.

Those who have already registered under the permanent registration system and who have voted during the last two years do not have to re-register.
