

Start Construction Of New Big Beaver Telephone Exchange

BIG BEAVER, May 9—Sidewalk superintendents now are on hand to help the Michigan Bell Telephone Company erect its new \$27,500 community dial office building for this community. Walter B. Fauser, manager, announced.

Fauser said the dial-conversion program will cost \$22,000 before it is completed. Better than \$11,000 has been allocated for the 23 miles of cable required, \$155,000 for the dial switching equipment needed, and \$21,600 for the installation of dial instruments in the homes and offices of subscribers.

The job of installing the new dial instruments, which will remain alongside the old telephones until they are actually connected, will take several months, Fauser said.

This step will take place prior to the change over from manual to dial service, he said and new numbers then will be assigned to the 1,600 customers involved.
