with the equipment he now has.  
**JOHN BASCH OF THE Veteran's Disposal Service** attended the meeting and questioned the ability of Stewart to fulfill the contract with single axle trucks.  
He stated that his company has been given two tickets because of overloading and now intends to get three more tandem wheeled trucks.  
City Engineer L. R. Gave said that 3,000 more pounds will be permitted with tandem wheeled trucks than single axle vehicles.  
Egbert said he would check over all figures and suggestions made Monday and report back at the Nov. 18 meeting. The contract is

expected to be awarded at this session.  
CITY COMMISSION also approved the city manager's recommendation that billing for garbage collection service be made after the service has been performed on a three-month basis. The city attorney will prepare the necessary amendment to the ordinance in order to make the unpaid charges for garbage collection a lien on the property.  
Egbert stated, "At the present time, billing for garbage collection service is performed by the water department and each bill contains a statement for water, sewage disposal and garbage. more strict enforcement of two-way traffic laws.  
The council suggestion of pedestrian in all police cars is fully met in Birmingham, although NSC rating on this was low. Chief Ralph W. Moxley said all cars now are equipped for car-to-car calls, station-to-car and car-to-car calls.  
The only vehicle not so equipped is the motorcycle used mainly to patrol street parking areas.

ANOTHER COUNCIL recommendation is a broader traffic program in the schools. They point out that adult attitudes on traffic safety are important to children and urge PTA participation in the program.

School faculty personnel participation is also suggested as a means of getting great traffic safety established among schools.

While no faculty member in Birmingham has participated in the program, Police Lt. Henry Timm also visits schools regularly for traffic discussions.  
Another council suggestion, driver training in the high schools, is also being considered. A dual-control car is available for high school students at all times.  
A total of 70 among 35 cities studied, Birmingham was advised that a more comprehensive program of public information should be undertaken. The present publicity is carried on through newspaper articles, special traffic safety articles, school discussions, talks before service clubs, church groups and the PTA.

### To Recommend Gas Safety Measures To Legislature

A special legislative committee formed last year as a result of a fatal gas explosion in Birmingham Dec. 11, 1949, will recommend to the State Legislature that a bill be passed to set up compulsory state inspections of new gas transmission lines.  
Another recommendation will be to establish statewide inspections of trucks carrying flammable liquids and liquefied petroleum gas.

THE FIRST BILL would require the Michigan Service Commission to inspect installations of new gas lines. The commission can now only inspect lines with permission of gas companies.

These bills will be presented to the legislature next year.  
Representative Howard R. Estes of Birmingham offered a resolution in the State House in March of 1950, calling for a special legislative committee to study safety regulations governing gas distribution systems and make suggestions concerning corrective legislation.

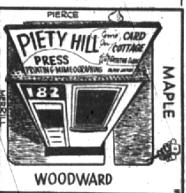
