

### Troy Twp. Girl Among Victims Of Tragic Crash

One Troy township girl was killed and another seriously injured in the head-on crash which took the lives of six persons on Opdyke road, north of Pontiac, early Saturday morning.

Killed in the accident were four teenagers and a Leonard couple, parents of 11 children.

The Troy resident killed was Patricia Harwell, 16, of 2034 John R. In serious condition in Pontiac General Hospital is the crash's only survivor, Jeanette Palmer, 16, of 2720 Woodstin, Troy township.

**ALSO KILLED** were Raymond Smith and Richard Burgess of Clawson, Frank Swift of Royal Oak, and Mr. and Mrs. Murray Moore of Leonard.

The accident occurred when the Smith youth, who was driving south on Opdyke, swerved into the northbound lane into the path of the vehicle driven by Moore.

Messages have been received from various parts of the country offering aid to the 11 Moore children, who were orphaned because of the tragedy.

Funeral services for Miss Harwell were held Tuesday in Clawson and the Riverside Tabernacle, Flint. Burial was in Flint Memorial cemetery.

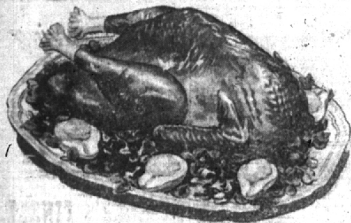
