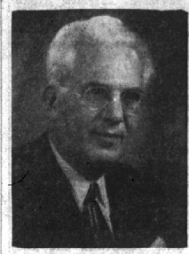

## Senator Ferguson to Speak at AAUW Event

Homer Ferguson, Senior Senator from Michigan, will be the speaker at the Guest Night Program at the Community House.

8:15 Wednesday evening, November 21, at the Community House. Senator Ferguson has chosen "Washington" for his topic.

**THE SENATOR**, a long-time resident of Detroit, began his rise to national prominence in 1939. At that time, a Circuit Court Judge, he served as a one-man grand jury investigating gambling and vice rackets.

In the fall of 1942 he was elected to his Senate post. He has served actively on the Senate Judiciary Committee and also on the Senate Appropriations Committee.

Senator Ferguson, a native of Harrison City, Pa., attended the University of Pittsburgh and then the University of Michigan, receiving his degree of Bachelor of Law there in 1918. He holds the honorary degree of Doctor of Law, conferred by Kalamazoo College and by the Detroit College of Law.

Mrs. Ferguson will accompany her husband. She is editor-in-chief of the Washington News-Letter, and active on several boards in Washington.
