

Laundromat to Open Here Dec. 5

A Laundromat Half-Hour Laundry will be opened at 1287 South Woodward, Wednesday, Dec. 5, by Norman A. Barrett, a former Birmingham resident who now lives in West Bloomfield township.

The new laundry will have 20 machines, a drying service and a small mangle, Barrett stated.

As an additional service, patrons may leave their soiled clothing and pick it up later. If the customers operate the machines themselves, they never need to put their hands in water, Barrett pointed out.

The Laundromat is located at the corner of Woodward and Humphrey, and will be open daily and evenings.

Birmingham commissioners are asking the Michigan Municipal League to explain the \$54 increase in annual dues before including the amount in their annual budget.

In announcing the increase, Henry J. DeVeto, League president, stated only that the increase applied to the 1950 population in Birmingham and was due to "normal inflationary factors."
