

U. of M. Alumnae Hear Dr. Davis At Dec. Meeting

Professor Joe Lee Davis of the University of Michigan will be the speaker at the December meeting of the Birmingham Alumnae Association of the University of Michigan.

PROFESSOR DAVIS

The meeting will be held at eight o'clock Thursday evening, December 6, at the home of Mrs. Hugh D. Backus, 123 Latham road.

Professor Davis will speak on "American Winners of the Nobel Prize."

DR. DAVIS is a native of Lexington, Kentucky. He received his bachelor's degree from the University of Kentucky in 1920, and earned his master's degree there the following year.

Prior to joining the faculty of the University of Michigan where he is professor of English, Dr. Davis taught at the University of Kentucky. He came to Ann Arbor as instructor in 1930, and attained the rank of full professor there last July.

His main fields include teaching courses in Shakespeare, American literature, and modern novel, and he has contributed often to literary publications.

He is co-author (with John T. Frederick of Notre Dame and Frank L. Mott of the University of Missouri) of a two-volume work entitled "American Literature: An Anthology and Critical Survey."

DR. DAVIS currently serves on both the Executive Committee and the Graduate Committee of the English department. He is a member of the Michigan Academy, Modern Language Association, and the National Council of Teachers of English.

Mrs. Gordon Davis, president of the Birmingham chapter, will preside at the meeting. Mrs. Dwight Ensign is chairman of the day.

Engineering Details Delay Cherry Ct. Sewer

The city should make no promises unless it can keep them, declared City Commissioner Lancel Minor to his colleagues at Monday night's meeting.

His statement came in connection with the city's promise last spring that the Cherry court sewer would be installed during the summer.

He asked City Manager D. C. Egbert whether the sewer has been put in.

When the answer was in the negative, Minor commented, "I'd rather see the city make no promises than be unable to keep the ones it makes."

CITY ENGINEER L. R. Gare said his department believed it would be more economical and better engineering if the proposed Chester-Wallace interceptor were put down Cherry court instead of Stanley, thus avoiding the need for a separate Cherry court sewer.

Commissioners instructed Egbert to notify Cherry court residents that the engineering problems have not been completely solved and that is why the sewer hasn't been put in.

Man Allowed 60 Days To Get Property Owner Assignments On Refunds

Commissioners have given John D. Harrison 60 days in which to secure assignments from property holders in the Derby paving assessment district.

Harrison, who paid the estimated \$289.29 when the district was created, said he felt the unexpended monies should be returned to him rather than present property holders, according to city charter. Refunds involved total \$280.71.

In the district created for the paving of Bannville, from Grant to Edgewood, refunds of total \$1,011.82, although expenditures exceeded the estimated cost by \$308.36.

Commissioners pointed out that interest collected on the original appropriation of \$8,827 amounted to \$1,250.12.
