**To Attend Youth-  
Govt. Conclave**

Robert Thalacker, David Joki-  
nen, Gary Osterbeck, and Bud  
DeLoria will accompany Edwin F.  
Kierbert of the Birmingham YMCA  
to the "Youth in Government"  
program at the State Capitol  
building in Lansing Friday and  
Saturday.

The boys will form part of a  
conclave of 200 high school  
youths working as a mock legis-  
lature in enacting bills devised by  
them.

State officers and department  
heads will be elected at legisla-  
tive sessions and work directly  
with the men now holding those  
positions.

The elected Youth Governor will  
deliver an inaugural address and  
the boy Lieutenant-Governor will  
preside over the Senate. The  
Speaker of the House will be  
elected by and preside over the  
body and the Secretary of State  
will be the user of the state seal.

PURPOSE OF THE Youth in  
Government program is to prepare  
a selected group of young people  
for moral and political leadership  
in the American democratic process  
by providing guidance, training,  
and experience in the theory and  
practice of determining public  
policy.

The program is under the direction  
of the Michigan State YMCA and  
the local boys are sponsored  
by the Birmingham Rotary club.  
Sessions start Friday at 10:30 and  
continue until the Governor's ad-  
dress at 5:30 p.m. The group re-  
convenes Saturday and adjourns  
at 4 p.m.

**Makes Impressive  
Showing at Harvard**

CAMBRIDGE, Mass: Bob Hardy, Harvard sophomore  
from Birmingham, Mich. is likely to loom big in the fu-  
ture plans of head Crimson football coach Lloyd Paul  
Jordan, who has termed him a "good sophomore prospect."

The son of Mr. and Mrs. Fran-  
cis B. Hardy, 851 Hazelwood, Bob  
was awarded the Harvard Club of  
Eastern Michigan scholarship  
when he entered the nation's oldest  
university, and currently holds  
a Harvard College scholarship.

ALTHOUGH HE DIDN'T play  
freshman football, the local grid-  
der won his varsity uniform this  
year in his first season with the  
Crimson 11, and has seen consid-  
erable service as a defensive line  
backer. He started the Army and  
Dartmouth games at defense and  
has been used considerably in  
other tilts, notably the Columbia  
contest.

An injury kept him out of the  
Princeton encounter and a limited  
service against Brown.

Still needing the experience  
that makes a polished performer,  
Hardy, nevertheless, tackles hard  
and plays with enthusiasm. With  
graduation claiming several mem-  
bers of the starting defensive unit,  
it is likely he will have a chance  
to move up next fall.

He is also listed as an offensive  
quarterback, but has seen little  
service in this role.
