**Southfield Policing Matters Discussed**

Southfield township is getting good police protection, Captain Frank Van Atta of the Oakland County sheriff's department told township board members at a special meeting last Thursday evening.

Township authorities have recently heard a number of complaints from residents claiming that there is insufficient police protection in Southfield. As a result, Supervisor William Roesser requested the sheriff's department to send a representative to the meeting.

Van Atta outlined the number of calls sheriff's officers answered this year from January to July in the county and Southfield. He emphasized that these runs were only for members of the uniformed division.

They are January, county, 454; Southfield, 52; February, county, 587; Southfield, 64; March, county, 558; Southfield, 62; April, county, 605; Southfield, 57; May, county, 624; Southfield, 67; June, county, 609; Southfield, 64; July, county, 730; Southfield, 71. Southfield ranked second in the

pay taxes and are entitled to protection.

Other townships in the county paying for sheriff's officers are Waterford and Troy, two each; and Pontiac, White Lake and Novi—Commerce, one each.

Some residents have stated that they have called the sheriff's department concerning persons creating disturbances and upon arrival, the officers would not make arrests.

Van Atta said that in many cases, officers can't make an arrest without a warrant. He pointed out when no misdemeanor is committed in the presence of the officer, the complaint is supposed to be a warrant through the prosecutor's office.

ROESSER SAID he would confer with the county prosecutor to find out how residents can secure warrants easier.

There has been some talk concerning the township forming its own police department. Van Atta stated that this would be quite an expensive matter. He pointed out that Southfield should have at least eight policemen for a department.

The captain told board members, "In proportion, you are having no more break-ins than any other areas in the county or the whole region."

Van Atta explained that the sheriff's department has a big job with its limited staff. So far this year, a total of 4,428 prisoners have been in the county jail.

There is a total of 20 men in the uniformed division. However, six of these are permanently stationed at the jail.

This leaves 23 men for patrol duties to be divided into shifts throughout the day. Of this amount, 10 are on the force through township contributions.

In other business at the meeting, the assessment roll for paving in Magnolia subdivision was improved. Amount of the roll is \$12,988.50.
