Traffic Changes In Effect for Next 30 Days

Several traffic recommendations submitted by Birmingham Highlands Property Owners association in July are to be tried out for a 30-day period, during which time the property owners and police department can observe the results.

At the end of the 30 days, the changes will be submitted to the city commission for approval. The recommendations were studied by the city's traffic consultants, Gunderson and DeBellek.

RECOMMENDATIONS accepted include installation of stop signs on Midvale at Glenhurst

prior to opening of the new high school; shrubbery to be trimmed at Avon Lane and Argyle; and making Cranbrook a through street as soon as necessary signs can be installed.

In addition, 25 MPH speed limit signs have been placed on Glenhurst. New sidewalks will eventually be constructed on the south side of Maple from Glenhurst to Midvale.

Some of the recommendations of the association were not accepted by the traffic engineers.

Oscar Gunderson's report stated, "At the intersection of Glenhurst and Midvale, the association recommended stop signs in all directions. In our opinion a four-way stop sign is unreasonable at this intersection and our recommendation is that stop signs be placed at Midvale at Glenhurst just prior to opening of the high school."

THE PROPOSAL to stop Avon Lane at Argyle is not approved. Shrubby at this location should be adjusted so as to improve visibility.

"At Glenhurst and Maple it was recommended that portable linkers be in operation during hours of school traffic, that patrol boys be on duty and consideration be given to detaining a police officer to this location.

"This intersection should not be used as a school crossing. Children going to and from Quanton school should cross Maple at Cheslerfield.

The engineer's report also pointed out, "The recommendation to place a traffic signal at Cranbrook and Maple is not approved at this time. Present traffic volume at this intersection is not sufficient to warrant an installation. Volume will be checked again after the high school is in operation. It is recommended, however, that Cranbrook be made a through street."

Reverse Decision In Southfield On Zoning Change

A statement in "Robert's Rules of Parliamentary Procedure" enabled the Southfield township board Tuesday evening, to retract an amendment to the zoning ordinance it made two weeks ago.

At the Sept. 23 meeting, the board accepted the zoning board's recommendation that all homes in sections five and six in the township, between 13 and 14 Mile roads and Inkster and Telegraph now zoned residential four, be changed to residential five. Minimum size for homes zoned residential five is 20,000 square feet.

When Frederic K. Graf, Franklin realtor, heard of this change, he stated he was opposed to it and in addition, was out of town during July when the matter was placed in legal advertisements.

TOWNSHIP BOARD MEMBERS two weeks ago passed the amendment on a 4-3 vote. At that time, they pointed out they were approving the change because

there were no objections. Robert's Rules state that a group can reconsider its decision on an amendment only at the next regular meeting following the original decision.

Graf stated that he owns lots in the Franklin area that are too small on which to build a house of 20,000 cubic feet.
