### Cranbrook Shows New Gem Display

As part of an elaborate display of uses of titanium, the Cranbrook Institute of Science opened an exhibition Oct. 1 featuring a wide variety of titanium gems.

These stones, of titanium dioxide, are especially handsome for their brilliance of special refraction, a quality in which they surpass the diamond, demonstrated by immersion of both stones in water.

The stones, produced in an electric arc, are on artificial nuclei. The greater number have a slightly yellowish cast, but run to red, blue and yellows, through the purposeful introduction of additional elements. Titanium gems are in limited production and very few have reached the jewelers market.

**USE OF titanium** for the production of white powder used in paints, white wall tires, enamels and porcelain is illustrated as are the uses of alloys which have the special characters of lightness and toughness.

The exhibition is open to the public every day from 2 to 5 p.m. through November. It was lent to the Institute by the National Lead company.
