

Reserves Down Waterford 19-0

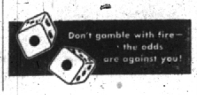
Chalking up its second win of a four game schedule, the Birmingham reserve football squad downed Waterford last week there 19-0.

Maple fullback Mickey O'Connor scored the first six points for Birmingham in the first minutes of the first quarter and Jerry Wedge hit pay dirt a few minutes later. Kicks for conversion by Wedge were blocked but the score was 12-0 at the end of the quarter.

In the second half, Waterford's Kerry Keating ran 77 yards only

to be brought down by Payson Chapman on the one yard line. At this point the locals showed defensive strength by holding back their opponents for four successive downs.

In the fourth quarter Maple scorers Wedge and O'Connor combined their ability when Wedge caught O'Connor's pass and legged it for a 50 yard touchdown. Wedge kicked the conversion for Birmingham's final point.

REV. LAWRENCE W. PEARSON Cranbrook Pastor Resigns Office

Announcement was made Sunday by the Rev. Robert L. DeWitt, rector of Christ Church Cranbrook, of the resignation of the Rev. Lawrence W. Pearson from the church staff. He has accepted a call to return to the Diocese of Olympia, Washington, where he will take the office of "Canon of the Ordinary", special assistant to the bishop.

Mr. Pearson came to Cranbrook two and a half years ago from that diocese where he had served as rector of St. Andrew's church in Aberdeen. His duties at Cranbrook have been chiefly with the educational program and ministry of the church.

He has also been chaplain at University hospital, Ann Arbor; vicar of Brighton and rector of Hamburg. Prior to entering the ministry he taught school in the Philippines and Japan.

The Pearson family will leave shortly after the first of November for Washington.
