Football Fans Gather For Cocktails, Dinner

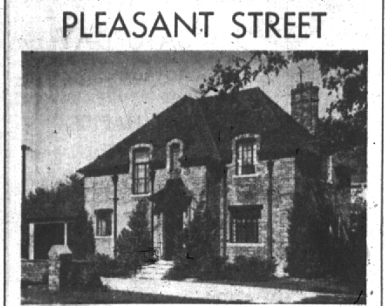
