Home Nursing Instructors Will Receive Training At the Community House

The American Red Cross will sponsor a class at the Birmingham Community House, beginning Oct. 29, to train instructors in home nursing. Classes will be held Monday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings for 8 hours, beginning at 7 p.m. A total of 30 hours instruction will be given.

Those taking the training will be required to teach one home nursing class with supervision, according to Mrs. Paul Benson, chairman of home nursing for the Oakland county chapter, ARC.

She said home nursing instructors are badly needed at this time to meet civil defense needs. Application blanks may be obtained from the ARC office in Pontiac.

'Y' Offers Swim Instruction to Birmingham Boys

The Birmingham 'Y' has arranged with the Downtown Branch of the Detroit YMCA to give swimming lessons to a group of 80 boys over a 10-week period starting Nov. 10.

Each class of which there are two, will be limited to 30 boys. They will spend 30 minutes in the water each Saturday morning from 10 to 10:30 and 10:30 and 11, going through a series of progressive swimming lessons.

Local arrangements for enrolling boys can be made with the Birmingham 'Y' at its office at 144 West Maple.

Annexation of Troy Twp. Protested

A petition submitted to the Troy township board Monday evening requested that a half-mile parcel of land in the township not be annexed by the city of Clawson.

The 38 signers live on Elmford, adjacent to Clawson. City officials previously sent out letters to residents of this area asking if they would like to be annexed.

TROY TOWNSHIP supervisor Norman H. Barnard stated the petition was accepted and filed. Although the township board has taken no official position concerning the proposed annexation, some board members have expressed opposition to any such move.

Residents in the Elmford area now receive water from Clawson and city officials have pointed out that these persons should live there to benefit from such service.

Barnard points out that Clawson residents living on 12 Mile road between Crooks road and Selfridge are getting water from Troy.

The portion of Elmford which concerns Clawson officials lies between Rochester and Main.
