Woodward Meter Changes to Make Parking Easier

Motorists parking on Woodward avenue will find themselves with a little more room to maneuver their cars and to get in and out of them in the near future.

Work was started a week ago on widening the space between cars parked along the street, as recommended by traffic engineers who are making a city-wide survey here.

The new "slots," eight and a half feet wide, will add greatly to the safety of motorists both in parking and leaving their cars, the engineers pointed out. It will permit a car, pulling into an unoccupied slot, to move off the street even though a door is open on a nearby vehicle.
