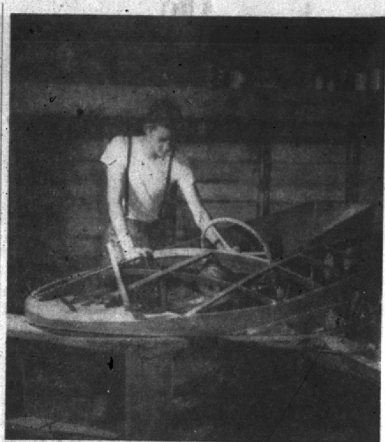

Youth Constructing 8 1/2-Foot Hydroplane

 Putting his summer vacation to a constructive use is 16-year-old Tom Telfer, 780 Greenwood, who is building an 8 1/2 foot hydroplane at his home.
 The hull of the craft should be completed this week and another week will be taken to apply the finish.
 The young craftsman is constructing the boat for Dick Wright of Detroit, a classmate at Culver Military academy.
 EQUIPPED WITH A 7 1/2 horsepower outboard motor, the boat which is called "Ko-Mo-Shun" is expected to do about 45 miles an hour.
 Construction was started about three weeks ago, and the craft is being built from plans which Telfer sent away for. Made of plywood and some spruce, the hydroplane will be painted light blue with white on the bottom.
 Wright intends to take the boat to Florida and put it in use this winter. Both boys are also making plans to enter it in racing competition.
 Telfer will construct his own hydroplane next summer with Wright's assistance. Boat's name will be "Miss Birmingham."
 When Tom returns to Culver Sept. 11, he will be a junior. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Gilbert L. Telfer.
