Plans were also made for a bulletin to be published this year and for additional publicity which will explain the Community Council and what it does.

Troy Schools Have Record Enrollment

A record total of 2,058 students are enrolled in Troy Township schools, according to Superintendent Stuart Baker.

Attendance according to schools are Troy Unit 143; Troy two, 123; Smith, 94; Coleridge, 191; Beaver, 414; Log Cabin, 191; and all elementary. These schools are in attendance for total figures for grades kindergarten through sixth are 1,283.

Last June, 218 students enrolled in Troy elementary grades.

IN THE NEW high school, which accommodates grades seven through 12, there are 775 pupils. This shows a 120-pupil increase over the 655 total for June.

At last week's school board meeting, six new instructors were hired.

They are Vivian Dunn, second grade; Poppleton school; Frieda Hart, fifth grade; Log Cabin; Mildred Hutchinson, physical education; Troy high school; Eugene Swanson, industrial arts; Log Cabin school; Edith M. Wiggins, kindergarten; Log Cabin; and Ethel Cantrell, first grade, Poppleton.

In other business, the board authorized the purchase of another school bus. Township school system now will have 10 buses.

Health Films Available For Club Use

Mrs. Anne Gillette, city health nurse, reminded Birmingham clubs of the film loan library maintained by the Michigan Department of Health.

"There are pictures on 70 different health subjects which can be borrowed from the department," she said. "They are planned for showing in classrooms, club meetings or community gatherings this fall and winter."

"There are sound films, color films and silent films as well as animal films, first aid, first aid, safety, nutrition and the problems of the aging."

"Others which have been in much demand in the past include films on cancer, polio, immunization, colds, baby sitters, water and milk sanitation, dental health, human reproduction and care of the skin."



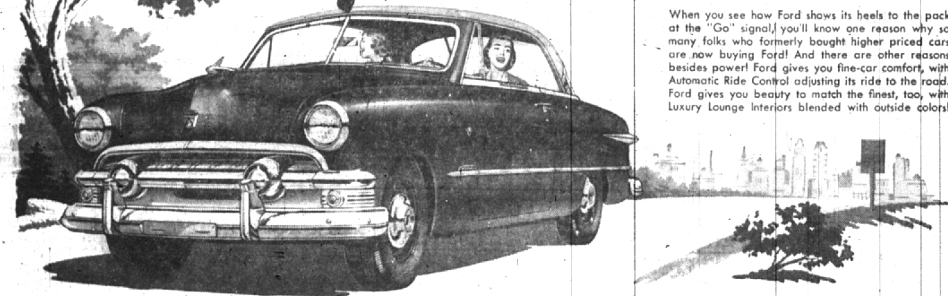


