Death Takes Auto Executive

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon in Plant for Fred C. Hillman, 2753 1/2 Backham boulevard, Lathrup Village, plant manager at Chevrolet's Detroit Forge division who died Saturday from a heart attack.

An auto pioneer, Mr. Hillman had been with the Chevrolet firm since 1916, when he started at the Mason Motor Car Co. in Flint.

After military service in World War one, he returned as a foreman at the Flint Chevrolet plant. In 1943, Mr. Hillman was named manager of the Chevrolet aviation engineering division.

Surviving are his wife, Hattie; a son, L. Harry L.; a daughter, Helen of Arlington, Mass.; two grandchildren, Lynn Sue and Fred Charles II; and a brother, Louis Jr. of Flint.

Zoning Changes Approved by Southfield Board

Several recommendations of the Southfield zoning board were approved by the township board Tuesday evening.

One change provides that all areas in sections five and six, now zoned residential four be changed to residential five. This area is between 14 and 13 Mile roads and Telegraph and Inkster. Minimum lot size for homes in residential five classification is 20,000 cubic feet. The change will not affect areas in these sections which are zoned residential two.

The board also approved the rezoning of a 40 acre parcel on the north side of Nine mile road between Southfield and Greenfield to permit erection of a television tower and antenna by the Fort Industry Co. of Birmingham. The firm owns WJBK-TV.

Other changes were to rezone an area in Grand River Park subdivision from residential one to commercial one zone, and rezone M. J. Murphy's Orchard's Estates subdivision in section 22 from residential two to three.

Rezoning of the area in Grand River Park subdivision will permit the erection of a building on Eight Mile road by the Walworth Tractor and Equipment Co.

In other business at Tuesday's meeting, Supervisor William Rouse was authorized to negotiate for re-zoning of the township hall. Building Inspector Frank Gidycz was also authorized to employ an assistant building inspector.

Gare Represents City for Weight, Gas Revenues

City Engineer L. R. Gare was appointed by the city commission Monday evening as Birmingham's administrator for state gas and weight revenue returned to the city.

State Highway Commissioner Charles M. Ziegler requested the city to appoint an administrator "who shall be responsible for and shall represent the municipality in all transactions with the state highway commissioner pursuant to the provisions of this act."

SO THAT REVENUES derived from the state gas and weight tax may be properly distributed, the new act provides that all streets be classified.

The highway commissioner said that the state auditor general will soon forward a voucher for \$4,000,000 as Birmingham's share of the first distribution of the new motor vehicle highway fund.

Resident Praises Development Around West Maple Bridge

City officials received a rare type of letter this week. Unusual feature was that it contained praise from a resident.
