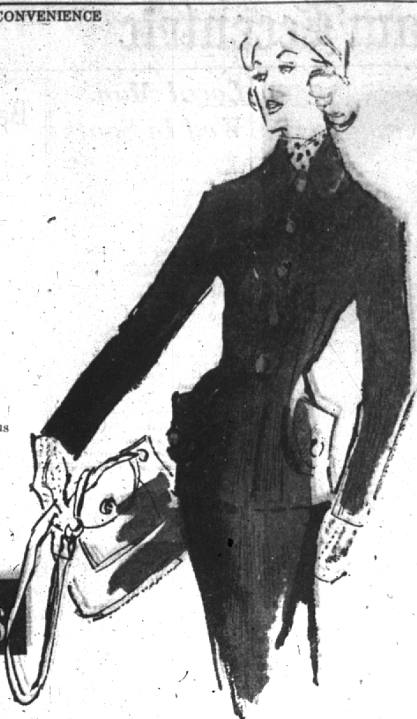

In 1950 Mrs. Licklider became Research Assistant at the Museum of the Cranbrook Academy of Art.

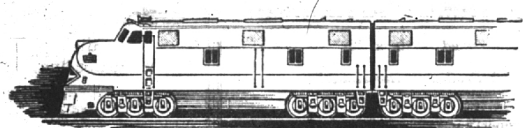
Now Mrs. Licklider said, of her new position, "I'm delighted to be associated with such a stimulating place and person."

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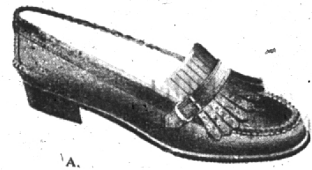
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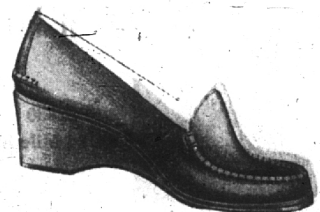

A. "Kiltie," a brown calf moccasin loafer made for comfortable casual wear on or off-campus. 9.95



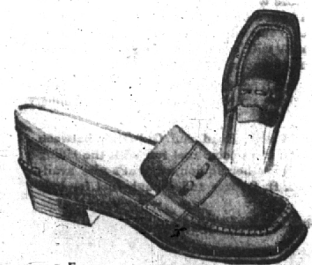
