**To the Editor:**  
Congratulations to the 69 voters and the voters who blocked the city commission and the city manager from spending \$350,000 for a new fire station.

We think they should have shown the public where they expected to spend this money, how much of it was going for real estate, from whom it was going to be purchased, and a few other pertinent facts because there are contractors in Birmingham that are estimating a fire station cost at around \$150,000, and a good sized one.  
It might be well for the boys at the city hall to take a junket, by invitation, over to the western zone and see the new fire station that Bloomfield Village built for \$145,000, and also the new fire trucks, at a total cost for the entire outfit of around \$50,000.

IN OTHER words, you could have seven of these planted all over Birmingham for close protection for the same amount of money that the city hall wanted to spend for one.  
They argue that they want a residence for the firemen. Well, you can have most any residence up and down Cranbrook road for \$40,000 to \$60,000 and this should be fine enough for a group of firemen, and we think the builder would not throw in a good television and radio set for that money.  
If you add the cost of the fire station, you still would have only \$100,000, and here they are proposing to spend \$350,000 and this amount for one fire station.

WE APPRECIATE in the eastern zone they do things in a big way, but spending three and one-half times what is necessary to get a fire station is a poor way to impress the public.  
Our personal opinion is that Birmingham's lack of money is not the reason.
