**St. Dunstan's Current Show Is Delightful Curio**

Every once in awhile the New York theatre stages a play with all the qualities that should endear it to its patrons. But for reasons known only to its backers, it struts a little hour or two and is gone.

Maybe it was the season or the competition that took "The Curious Savage" off Broadway before mid-westerners saw it in any numbers at all. Perhaps it was because the New York producers of this play a season or two ago overacted it.

Not so with the group of players out at Bloomfield producing "The Curious Savage" at St. Dunstan's this week.

HERE IS AN entertaining show, with a warmth and depth to its message such as you seldom find in modern theater. Director Marjorie Smith, whose work at Cranbrook Summer Theater is well-known, has done a superb job with her cast of twelve characters, some sane, some slightly sane, others "in transition."

The playwright, John Patrick, has left it to the audience to discover the sanity in the questionable folks, and the insanity in the people of position and importance. The mixture is amusing and museworthy, and a most engaging evening in the theater.

Charlotte Adams does an outstanding job of a highly difficult part, that of Fairy May, a delightful elderly lady with mixed mentalities.
