Need Nurses Now For Polio Cases

Registered nurses are needed immediately to care for the sudden surge of polio patients in Ann Arbor, Michigan, Iowa, Wisconsin and Illinois, according to National headquarters of the American Red Cross, St. Louis, Mo. The Pontiac branch of the Red Cross Monday received a telegram from the organization's headquarters that nurses are desperately needed for at least a two-month period to care for patients suffering early stages of the disease when much can be done to offset crippling paralysis. Mrs. Leroy Vandever, Bloomfield Hills, chairman of nursing services of the Red Cross in this area, asks that all registered nurses that may not be practicing now or those who could be spared from present cases contact their local Red Cross chapter.
