VFW Post 2706 To Hold School

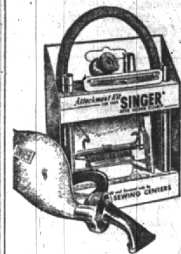

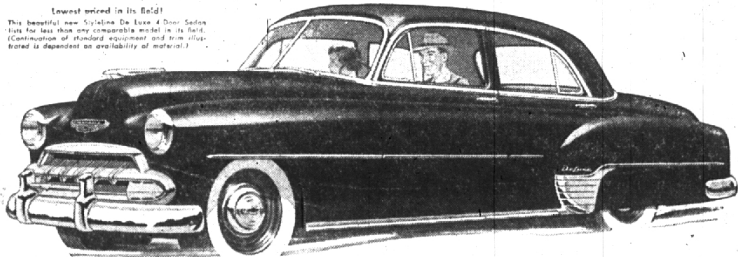
