**Alley Vacation  
Denied By City**

The city commission Monday night denied a petition of Richman, Coleman and Moss to vacate an alley from Abbey to Putney running at the rear of lots facing Adams. The firm is presently completing a terrace apartment development in this area and sought the vacation of the alley to add to the square foot volume of their land to permit the construction of two additional apartment units. The plan board formerly turned the request down on the basis that the added density in population was undesirable. The commission learned from City Attorney Forbes S. Hascall that the westerly side of the alley, upon vacation, would become city park property and that the city would be unable to sell this 10 foot strip to the firm without a vote of the people.

**Veterans May Receive  
Mustered Out Blanks  
At Municipal Building**

Area veterans of the Korean war may receive mustered out applications from E. S. Capron, service officer for the Oakland county Council of Veterans. Capron maintains local headquarters each Tuesday from 10 a.m. to noon in the health department offices at the Birmingham municipal building. Capron said that any member of the veterans' family could receive the application, but urged that Div. Form 214 be registered with the county clerk in Pontiac prior to the application. "This is a safety measure," Capron said. "The original of this form must be presented when the application is picked up. If it is lost the veteran is out of luck. He will, when having it registered, receive a certified copy which will cover him in case the original is lost."

**AUGUST GARDEN TIPS**

1. Divide VIRGINIA BLUE-BELL (*meritensis*) now as roots are dormant.
2. Cut off and burn the foliage of BLEEDING HEART.
3. Cut buds of HEAVENLY BLUE MORNING GLORY, that one about to open. Cut in evening and use in morning on breakfast table.
4. Cut HOLLYHOCKS to ground after blooming is done and burn all tops and leaves. Spray seedlings with MIKE SULPHUR.
5. Cuttings of ENGLISH IVY now will produce good winter house plants.
6. D W A R F EVERGREENS with small green worms must be sprayed with NICOTINE SULPHATE.
7. If white dots (scale) appear on EUONYMOUS vines, spray immediately with nicotine or pyrethrum or the vines may die.
8. Cut HERBS just before flowers open, dry in cool, airy, shady place.
9. Fertilize the LAWN preparatory to seeding. Be sure a high phosphate content fertilizer is used.
10. Keep spraying for BLACK SPOT until humid weather abates.
