Eye Requirement For New Business To Have Parking

The city's proposed parking zone classifications and amendments aimed at business district parking facilities were thoroughly reviewed in a two-hour session of the plan board and city commission Wednesday night, Aug. 20.

Proposed changes in the ordinance would set up two classifications for land use to cover only parking lots in the business area and in the residential zones...

THE ORDINANCES, still in the rough draft stage, were compiled by the plan board and Plan Technician Robert Boatman.

Wednesday night's meeting was an attempt of the plan board to get the opinion of city commissioners on Birmingham's parking needs.

UNDER PRESENT city ordinances, the city is compelled to order a business to close its parking lot requested for parking use.

CITY OFFICIALS point out that under this ordinance a business or institution, finding that it is unable to carry on its business...

Stringent specifications for yard lot parking spaces, and parking surfaces are set up in the ordinance in both the business and residential zones...

Under the ordinance, the city building inspector will issue the permit for the lot and may revoke the permit at any time that requirements are not complied with.

THE ENFORCEMENT of maintenance was sought by Plan Board Member William Brown and Boatman was instructed to write such a clause into the ordinance.

A FOUR-FOOT fence will be constructed around the field at the new high school and goal posts erected for all practices.

PROPOSED SPACE requirement regulations call for one square foot of parking area for every square foot of floor area in a business place or institution.
