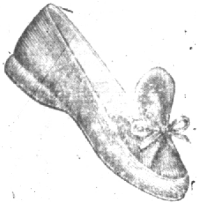

Seek Nominations For Jaycee Award Park Development

Nominating blanks for the Birmingham Junior Chamber of Commerce's 1952 distinguished service award are now being circulated to select the one Birmingham young man who has contributed the most in achievements, leadership and service to the city during the past year.

The award will be made January 14 at the Junior Chamber dinner at Adrian Cotta's. The local winner will become eligible for both state and national competitions among junior chamber members. Judging will be based on the individual's contributions to community and state welfare and betterment; participation in all-round community and state activities and civic enterprises, evidence of lasting contribution to the community; evidence of leadership; success in his own vocation and personal and business progress and cooperation with individuals and civic organizations.

MI. 6 Exchange Put Into Service Here This Week
Birmingham's 3,000 Midwest lines were opened for service by Michigan Bell Telephone company Monday, according to Walter Fauser, local manager. Fauser said that work was progressing rapidly on connecting the 3,000 installation requests which had piled up due to lack of facilities. He added that the installation and service picture would be entirely in the clear by Christmas.

"Some of the subscribers had been held up since last August, due to lack of numbers," Fauser said. "While we didn't get everything cleared away in the first couple of days, we did make good inroads in the pile-up, and by Christmas everything will be in tip-top shape."

"EVERYTHING held in reserve will be taken care of and I feel sure we will be handling additional subscribers as they are received." Fauser added that delivery of the new Birmingham phone directories will start Dec. 11, with some 16,000 books to be sent out. Subscribers in the Mayfair exchange will receive their books about Dec. 12, with the Mulberry books going out Dec. 17, when Royal Oak directories are delivered.

The Royal Oak team is by far the strongest team in the Oakland County table tennis league. Their players have won both state and national championships. Practice begins tonight at 7:00 p.m., prior to league play at 9 p.m. at the Pontiac Boy's Club.
