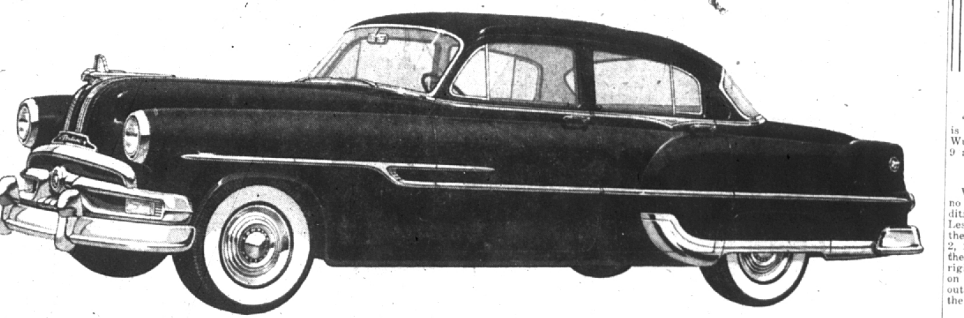
Christmas Music Marks Embury Church Services
