Male Choristers Present Concert Wednesday Night

Music sacred and secular will be combined Wednesday night, Dec. 10, in the annual Christmas concert presented by the Birmingham Male Chorus at the Community House.

Opening with Sach's stirring "Break Forth O'Beauteous Light" and closing with a selection of Christmas carols, the program will include 12 numbers by the chorus, a group of solos by baritone Rob-

ert Erwin and numbers by the Beauty Shop Quartette, four Royal Oak women affiliated with the Royal Oak Musicals.

THE QUARTETTE will present Christmas pieces as well as more common four-part harmony numbers.

Conducted by Otto Brown, Ferndale schools' director of music and conductor of many choral and instrumental groups; the chorus is made up of 30 voices. Accompanist is Nancy Finlay, a music teacher in the Ferndale school system who holds a Master's degree in music from the University of Michigan.

As a soloist and active member, Erwin has appeared many times with the chorus.

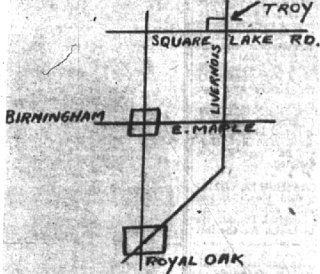
