**PLAY IT SAFE!**  
**Be Careful Hand Firing Coal Burners**

There may be a number of reasons why a furnace backfires smoke but improper firing is probably the most important and frequent.

Before adding fuel to the fire, rake the live coals to one side of the firepot, or to a cone in the center. Rake the live coals high enough that the fresh fuel will not cover them completely. Leave a "red spot" or a "bright spot".

Oxygen entering the firepot through the feeder door, or through the damper in the feeder door, plus the bright spot, will ignite the gas which forms when fuel is added. If this gas is kept burned off, you will get very little smoke from your chimney.

**IN FIRING AT night**, to last until the next morning, wait until the fire is burning well. Then close the ashpit damper and partly close the turn damper. Leave the over-draft partly open. You will have to do some experimenting until you have found out how much draft to use in your furnace.

Use a good grade of coal. Have your furnace cleaned and checked at least once a year, including the smoke pipe and chimney.

**PLAY IT SAFE!** You have your car serviced regularly, why not your heating plant? Your life may depend upon it.

Above all, do not store ashes in wooden or combustible containers, or hang hot poker or tongs on wooden partitions or put them near paper piles.

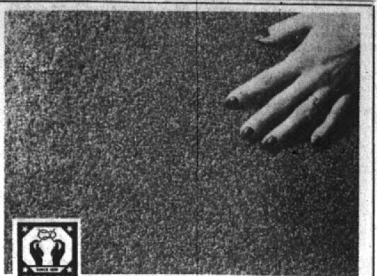

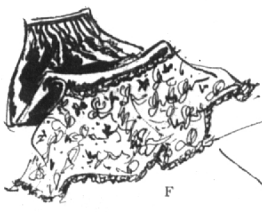
