Police Dept. to Employ Clerk

After studying a report submitted by Police Chief Ralph Mozley, analyzing the activities of the department during 1951, the City Commission Monday evening approved several recommendations.

A clerk will be employed in the department to handle clerical work. The chief notes that if the violations bureau is to be retained by the police department, additional clerical help is needed.

The City manager also was authorized to obtain quotations on an additional dictating machine and present them to the city commission.

Grand Trunk to Provide Greater Parking Space

Grand Trunk Railway officials are going to provide better parking facilities at the local station, according to a report this week by Police Chief Ralph Mozley.

Traffic and parking problems were recently discussed at a meeting between Oscar Gundersen, city traffic consultant, and A. W. Van Ripper, assistant engineer of the railroad.

Work is expected to start immediately, and will be completed within 45 days. Upon completion of the project, there will be space for 120 cars, and the area can be extended south if more parking is needed.

THE COMMISSION also approved City Manager Donald Eggers' recommendation that the proposal to transfer the violations bureau from its present location and placing it under supervision of the court be deferred.

Included in the chief's report was a survey of the use of manpower in his department. He also included suggestions regarding ways trained policemen's time could be more efficiently used.

He stated that the patrol procedure will be changed to enable more complete coverage of the entire city during the night and early morning hours.

Zoning Appeal Bd. Withholds Action

No action was taken at the Feb. 5 meeting of the Birmingham zoning board of appeals on the request of Mrs. Louise Haack for the permit to continue renting her East Maple property equipment.

The board contended that since the area was zoned for small business, her present use of it was illegal. Mrs. Haack contends that it had had such use prior to the zoning change. The board asked further information on dates before final action was taken.

THE NORTH Chevrolet's request to use a cinder block building on Ann street as a repair shop was temporarily denied. Neighbors said they feel the shop would create a nuisance and be unpleasant. The company was asked to establish that the work carried on in the building would not be obnoxious to the neighborhood before permission would be granted.

Harold Beisel, 1307 Davis, who had applied for permission to convert his home into a two-family dwelling, was informed that land restrictions would not permit the change.
