Life in Ancient Egypt To Be Seen in Display Now Shown at Cranbrook

An exhibition, "Life in Ancient Egypt," opened Feb. 26 at Cranbrook Institute of Science. Circulated by the American Federation of Arts and the Metropolitan Museum, the display will remain at Cranbrook for a month. It is supplemented by the Institute's own Egyptian collection.
 Dealing with ancient ways of living, religious customs and funeral rites the display includes gods, goddesses, sacred animals, tools and weapons, jewelry and toilet articles and stone and clay vessels.
 The intricate and painstaking workmanship of the ancient craftsman is evident in the beauty of the items which are shown.

BHS Speech Room Open to Public When Completed

Piisan Saarinen Swanegan's recommendation on a new type floor covering in the speech room at the new high school has been approved by Birmingham school board members.
 The covering, according to Dr. Dwight B. Ireland, superintendent, will be a rubber base, plastic-like surface designed especially for heavily-traveled areas. The material is cemented to the floor and can be scrubbed by hand or machine.
 In commenting on the new covering, Ireland explained that, although the use of the speech room had been denied to one group, it is not a permanent restriction.
 "WE DID ASK one group to find another place to present a program for children," he said, "because of the dirt which would be brought into the room. The landscaping around the school is not finished and a certain amount of mud would be tracked in. We felt that with small children, we could not avoid having a quantity of this fresh earth rubbed off on chair backs and seats."
 In addition, it should be understood in the community that the room is not completed. The floor covering is not down and several features of the stage and general equipment are still incomplete.
 "In spite of reports to the con-

trary, it is not the intention of the school board to deny the use of this room to the public once it has been completely furnished and equipped."
National Ayrshire Group Lists Area Man on Roster
 The unanimous election of R. K. Evans, 3115 Evergreen road, to membership in the Ayrshire Breeders' association has been announced by the national secretary, G. T. Conklin of Brandon, Vt.
