It is expected that the Fearn home will be back in shape for occupancy in two weeks. In the meantime, the family is living at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Edgar Swinson, 1745 Cambria.

Although the home was insured, the furnishings weren't covered.

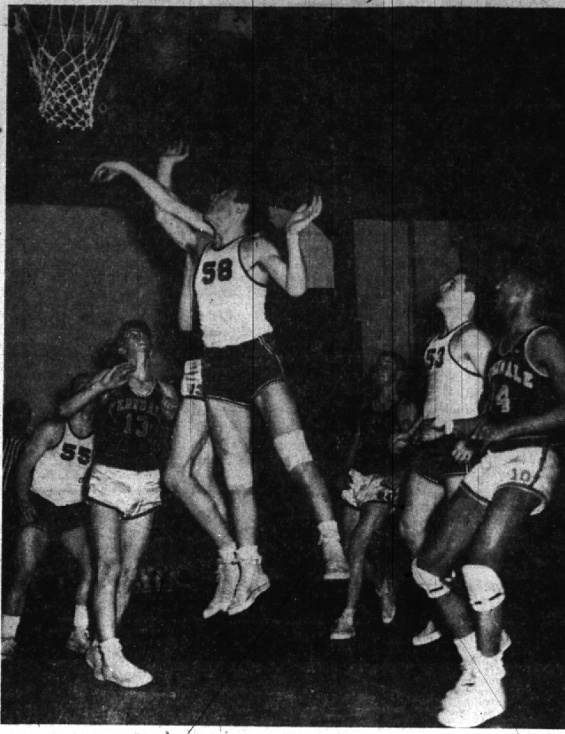

Ferndale Downs Local Squad

Taking full advantage of their superior height, the Ferndale Raisin-pitters romped to a 56-40 win over the Birmingham high school basketball team last Friday night in Baldwin gym.

With six-foot, four Jack Hodges leading the way, Ferndale controlled the backboards and scored many points on rebounds. Birmingham was hampered by shooting inaccuracy, the Maples sinking only 25% of their shots on their own home floor.

Ferndale was ahead all the way. With Tom Agar and Hodges sinking quick baskets, the Raisin-pitters went out in front and by halftime had opened up a 22-17 lead. Ferndale's defense kept Birmingham off balance, the Maples getting few good shots. Maple forward Jim Barger had some tough luck with three of his shots rolling around the rim before dropping out.

A second-half team all season, Birmingham played the Raisin-pitters on almost even terms after the intermission, scoring 23 points to Ferndale's 24. Ferndale's defense relaxed a little, allowing Gordon Mutch and Tom Tracy to break through for fairly easy baskets. The Raisin-pitters kept up their rebound work, however, to preserve their lead and clinch the victory.

HODGES WAS HIGH scorer with 19 points, while Howard McCray, a classy guard and spark-

plug of Ferndale's outfit, netted 15 more. Mutch has 13 points for Birmingham.

The victory preserved Ferndale's unbeaten record and league leadership. The Raisin-pitters are rated as one of the best high school teams in the state.
