Mt. Clemens Five Trounced By Birmingham

Running up the highest score of the season, the Birmingham high school basketball team welcomed Mt. Clemens 29-17 Tuesday evening on the Maple home floor.

Coach John Petrakis' team completely overwhelmed the Mt. Clemens outfit. With Tom Tracy sparking the attack in the opening minutes, the Maples poured in buckets at a torrid pace, to lead by 14 points at the end of the first quarter.

After the initial shock, the Bathers set up a pressing defense and battled Birmingham on almost even terms for the rest of the half, which ended with the Maples ahead 25-18.

In the second half, Birmingham kept up the pace, with the Maple forwards breaking through the Bathers' defense for lay-up shots while the guards popped them in from out on the floor. Jim Krause led a Mt. Clemens rally late in the third quarter, but the Maples tightened their defense and won going away.

An important factor was Birmingham's improvement in two departments, shooting accuracy and rebound work. The Maples hit on 27 of 71 field goal attempts for a 38.0 percentage, over 200 percentage points better than their showing against Ferndale.

ON THE BANKBOARDS, Don Jones, Jim Barger and Gordon Mutch outscored the taller Bathers to pull down a major share of the rebounds.

Mutch was high point scorer with 19 points, while Tracy added 16 more for the Maples. The latter's playmaking also featured the team. Stu Scheffele, steady guard, also played a stellar floor game.

The Birmingham reserves won an uphill struggle from Mt. Clemens seconds 41-39 on John Hubert's field goal in the last 15 seconds of play. At one point, the Maples trailed by 14 points. Payson Chapman sparked the Birmingham attack with 16 points.

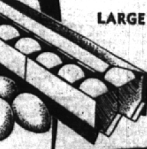
