MEN IN SERVICE

Awarded Combat Inf. Badge for Korean Fighting

WITH THE 7TH INFANTRY DIV. IN KOREA: P. Fredrick Pivitt, 23, son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Pivitt, 1240 East Lincoln, Birmingham, Mich., recently was awarded the Combat Infantryman badge for excellent performance of duty in combat with the 7th Infantry division.

The badge, a symbol of the front line fighting man, distinguishes the combat soldier from rear area and service troops. It consists of a miniature replica of a Revolutionary War Minuteman rifle mounted on a blue background and superimposed on a wreath.

PVT. PIVITT, a fireman in Headquarters Company, 17th Infantry regiment, entered the Army Nov. 24, 1951. He received basic training at Camp McCoy, Wis., and arrived in Korea on Oct. 19, 1951. He has been awarded the Korean Service ribbon with one campaign star.

Prior to entering service, Pivitt graduated from Birmingham high school and was later employed by the Pandora Products Co.

The United States navy and air force command is based at Keflavik, 35 miles from Reykjavik, capital of Iceland, on the southwest corner of the mid-Atlantic republic.

The Iceland Defense force was formed to provide for the joint defense of the North Atlantic treaty area.
