**City to Drop Self-Insured Program**

The city no longer will seek to insure itself against the first \$15,000 which would be paid out in compensation claims.

Instead, it will take out a regular yearly insurance policy covering all compensation risks.

City Commissioners Monday night approved the recommendation of the insurance advisory committee and Agent of Record Harold T. Hagan that the city abandon its self-insured program, started in July, 1949, in favor of an insurance policy on a guaranteed premium basis.

"I'm very glad to see the commission take this move, because now we can get off the keg of dynamite we've been sitting on," declared Commissioner Lance C. Minor.

THE \$24,000 the city has accumulated to pay possible claims would be wiped out with only two serious accidents to employees, he pointed out.

The city commission has approved the purchase of a right-of-way at the corner of West Maple and Westchesterway.

The property will be purchased for \$5,600 from Mr. and Mrs. James Wade. The portion on Westchesterway is 485 feet by 30 feet; and the West Maple strip is 27 feet by 150.

The purchase will give the city complete right-of-way on both West Maple and Westchesterway.

According to the agreement, a building now located in the right-of-way will be moved a little west and south of its present position.

**Hearing Slated For Paving on Yosemite-Villa**

A hearing has been called by the city commission for Monday, Feb. 18, to consider creation of a special assessment district for paving on Yosemite and Villa between Eton and Columbia.

Plans call for a 100% assessment against the property involved with the exception that the city will pay for the intersection costs at Villa and Eton and Yosemite and Eton.

Estimated cost of the improvement is \$16,570, according to City Manager Donald C. Egbert.

**WALTER SCHMIDT, representing the owners of all but three of the lots in the proposed assessment district, appeared at Monday's city commission meeting and requested the city to pay more than 15% of the cost.**

He stated, "These streets will be and are used by commuters. That constitutes a use of these streets by the public at large over and above the normal need for residential streets."

Egbert stated, "We have had no demand for street improvements there until this area was developed."

City Commissioner Ralph Main pointed out that all new developments have had to pay 100% since a recent charter change.
