## T. J. LaMeasure Dies Sunday

T. James LaMeasure, 750 Kensington, Bloomfield township, president of a large Detroit laundry died Sunday in his home. Oakland County Sheriff's officers said his death from a rifle shot wound was apparently self-inflicted. A rifle was found by his side.

Mr. LaMeasure was president of LaMeasure Brothers Laundry and Dry Cleaning Co. His wife Joan, told officers that he had been depressed recently.

MR. LAMEASURE WAS born in Detroit on May 9, 1909, and has spent his entire life in this vicinity. He was graduated from Culver Military Academy in 1927 and later attended the University of Detroit.

He married Joan Winborn in Birmingham on Jan. 26, 1935. He was a member of the Detroit Institute of Laundering, the Detroit Cleaners Institute and the Economics club of Detroit. He was also a member of St. James church of Birmingham.

He is survived by his widow and three children, Jan. 11; Tony, 7 and Christopher, 1. Other survivors include his mother, Mrs. W. J. LaMeasure; two brothers, Sherman L. and William J., and a sister, Mrs. William Uranick of Cleveland, Ohio.

Services were held Wednesday afternoon from the Manley Bailey funeral home, with burial in White Chapel cemetery. The Rev. Harold E. Towne of St. James Episcopal church officiated.

Sobieski of 2600 Crooks Road, Troy Township, before reporting for duty at Headquarters, Military Air Transport Service, Washington, D. C.

While on duty in Europe, the captain and his wife were able to visit France, Italy, Switzerland, Germany, Egypt, Libya, and England, and just returned to this country on board General Eisenhower's plane, the Sunflower II.

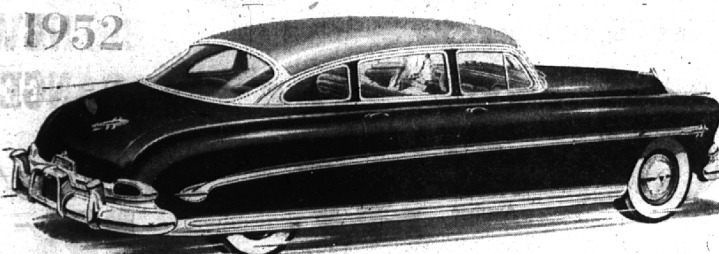
