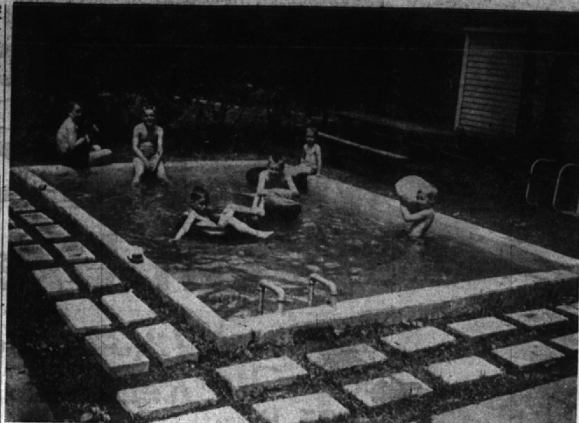

C. B. MINTURN HAS FIGURED OUT a way to keep his three kids and their neighborhood gang happy and occupied these hot summer days. In the Minturns' back yard on Yorkshire road is a small swimming pool, built last year by Minturn and which is getting a good work out this summer. The pool is 14 by 16 feet with a water depth of three feet. Minturn dug the hole and made the wooden forms for the cement walls. After necessary piping was installed by a plumber, a contractor poured cement for the walls and floor. The pool is kept bacteria free by the use of a commercial chlorine salt product. It is also kept clean from leaves and twigs by the use of a small screen every night. To prevent mud and dirt from being tracked into the house, Minturn has placed cement blocks around the outside of the pool as a track. Minturn has estimated that the pool has cost him last year's prices \$250 and that he considers that a very small investment for the amount of pleasure and fun all the children have from it. DAGA Tournament

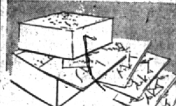

Board Questions Used Car Dealer's Right to Operate

A Southfield used car dealer will appear before board members Tuesday night to contest the recently passed "no-Sunday-sale" ordinance. He argued that he was operating his business without the sanction of the board.

Richard Conell recently opened a used car lot on the corner of Northwestern and Nine-Mile because he thought he "would be permitted to sell cars on Sunday." He told board members that the law was actually discriminatory against him because he was the sole dealer in the township when the ordinance was passed.

Board members, anxious to find out more about his business, discovered that he had never come before the board to gain board approval.

THEY QUESTIONED why the Oakland County Sheriff's department would approve the site for the lot without his application being approved by the township, and told Conell that he was operating his business "in peril" as far as the township was concerned.

No action was taken on the matter.

Hunter-Hamilton Crossover Denied

State Highway Commissioner Charles M. Ziegler has notified Birmingham city commissioners of the denial of a request for a Hunter Blvd. crossover opposite Hamilton avenue.

Ziegler said H. C. Coons, chief engineer and deputy commissioner, said such a crossover so close to the Maple intersection would create a very hazardous condition for trucking traffic, for which Hunter is intended.

He said the extension of Oak street to Hunter and a revision of the Woodward-Hunter intersection north of the city had been approved in principle but further details still remained which would have to be worked out.
