**Water Safety Plan Gets New Sponsors**

Several committees have already taken up the water safety program formerly carried on by the Oakland County Red Cross, and more are expected to do so shortly.

Under the leadership of Mark Smith, 1039 Piopl, water safety chairman, trained instructors are being made available to teach water safety or to train assistants. Lists and full information may be obtained from Smith or the Red Cross offices in Royal Oak and Pontiac.

The discontinuance of the program by the Red Cross is due to greater demands on chapter funds, officials said. The large amount needed for flood and tornado relief and the expanded blood program and tapped resources causing a curtailment in other lines.

IT WAS pointed out that some \$6,500 was spent last year by the Red Cross to teach water safety to children.

"We hope, this year, that local organizations in all back communities will pick up the program," Smith said. "Some already have, including Lake Orion, Rochester, Waterford township recreation department, Wing Lake recreation, the Lamplighter school in Royal Oak and others."

With this sort of a program being carried on by organizations, we feel water safety will be as widely taught in the county as it has been for the past two years," Smith concluded.
