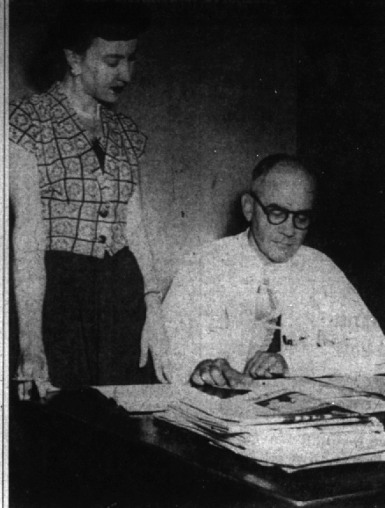

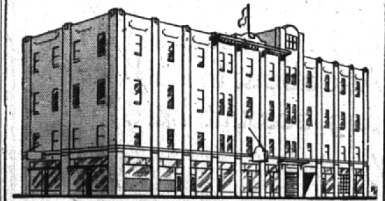
**Entertains Club**
