



This is the hat-wearing cedar which the conservation department recently reported being found in Chippewa county by Geotville lumbermen Robert Traylor and Henry Wajnaroski. This section was cut at a butt level 10 inches in diameter, and the now Bunyan-size hat encircles the cedar at height of 18 feet above ground. Annual rings indicate tree age at about 71 years. Hat apparently was placed on the cedar by a lumberjack about a half century ago.
