### Sunday Sermonette

A Continuing Series by Local Religious Leaders

### "LIVING AIMLESSLY OR LIVING WITH A SENSE OF MISSION."

If we would follow Christ and if our lives would be patterned after His, we cannot live aimlessly or without a purpose. Jesus said to Pilate, "To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto truth."

Christ was keenly conscious of His mission. When He was a lad of 12, He accompanied His parents to Jerusalem to celebrate the Feast of the Passover. After the observance of the passover the company from Nazareth started their return trip but Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem. Mary and Joseph thought that He was in the company, and when they could not find Him they returned to Jerusalem seeking Him. Not being able to locate Him they went to the Temple to pray for His safe deliverance.

**First Baptist**  
The Rev. Donald L. Spears, associate pastor, will preach on "What Does It Cost To Be A Christian?" taking for his text: Matthew 16:24. Then said Jesus unto His disciples, if any man will come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross, and follow me. The Biblical Baptism will be observed at this service.

**Christian Science**  
That an understanding of God gives us a fuller sense of life is shown in the Lesson-Sermon based on Revelation 21:6-7. "And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely. He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God and he shall be my son."

**First Presbyterian**  
The Rev. W. Glen Harris, Ph.D., will preach the first in a series of eight sermons from the Book of Isaiah. His topic will be "God Approaches Man," from verses in the first and fifth chapters.

### REV. DONALD SPEARS

There they found Jesus "sitting in the midst of the doctors, both asking and answering questions." His mother rebuked Him and He answered, "What ye not that I must be about my Father's business?"

His Father's business was ever close to His heart. He lived and died witnessing to the truth. Not only as a lad but in the beginning and continue all through His ministry. There was an abiding sense of mission in the heart of our Lord.

(John 9:4, "I must work the works of Him that sent me, while it is day; the night cometh when no man can work.")

**ALL THROUGH** the life of our Lord there is an emphasis upon a sense of mission. If we would be Christlike in our living, we, too, must feel that God has placed us here for a purpose. We must be about our Father's business.

God may have called you to a profession or field of labor. Grant that there may be in your heart a sense of divine commission and realization that God has put you there, not to live aimlessly, but to glorify Him through purposeful living, no matter what your occupation.

Just as Christ felt the necessity of witnessing for the truth so God calls each of us to witness for Him. Much can be accomplished and far-reaching results may be effected if we will only witness for our Lord.

Captain Charles Jones once told the story of Christ to a cabin boy named Soong. The lad became a Christian and the three following generations of his household. One of his descendants, Ma Yiling Soong, married Generalissimo Chiang Kai-Shek and the leadership of China then felt the impact of Christianity.

**THIS HAPPENED** because a Cabin boy learned the story of Jesus from a naval officer who was not ashamed to testify for his Lord and because, to a Chinese family, Christ really was a Saviour of sinners.

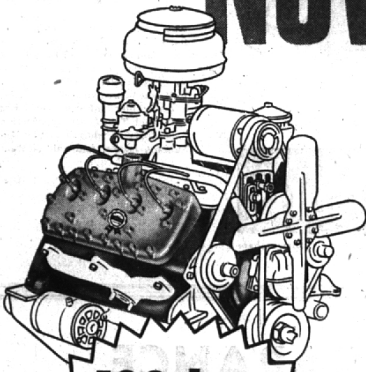
There was never a time when there was more need for Christian living and testimony by life and works than today. The world trend toward paganism can be stopped, it must be stopped!

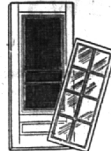
