**Ask Wider Eton According to City Agreement**

The city has been presented with a new development concerning the widening of Eton from Lincoln to Sheffield.

Edward Rose & Sons purchased the land from the city under the agreement that the city would widen Eton within nine months after the completion of water and sewerage connections.

The widening of this pavement was included in the contract awarded earlier this spring for concrete pavement. However due to objections on the part of Eton residents to the south, this portion of the pavement was deleted from the contract.

THE REST of the property owners were refunded their money but Edward Rose & Sons had already stipulated the pavement widening in their resale contracts and claim they may be liable to suits if the contract is not fulfilled.

Action on the problem has been deferred until the return from vacation of City Manager Donald C. Egbert next week.
