

Tree and Shrubbery Ordinance Altered By City Commission

The City Commission Monday night passed an amendment to the city's tree and shrub ordinance. The new amendment will give to City Manager Donald C. Eggers the authority to order removed any private shrubbery on public property that in any way interferes with the "visibility along any portion of a public highway." Prior to the passage of the amendment, the ordinance merely stated that the city could cut, trim or prune the hazardous shrubs, but did not say that the city had the power or right of removal.
